Introducing the Dispensing Doctors' Association (DDA)




The Dispensing Doctors' Association (DDA) represents over **6,600 doctors** currently working in **1,100 dispensing practices** across the UK. It is the only organisation that specifically represents the interests of dispensing doctors and their **9.9 million** patients.

The DDA meets regularly with the Department of Health and other agencies to promote the contribution dispensing doctors can make to rural health, and to achieve fair remuneration and reimbursement for their services.

- At the local level, DDA
 Board Members host visits
 to their practices and build
 relationships with constituency
 MPs. At the national level, DDA
 Board Members respond to
 Government consultations and
 attend all relevant professional
 events. DDA Board members
 also attend the annual political
 party conferences.
- Since its inception, the DDA has had many successes. The most notable example of DDA political lobby is the development and maintenance of the rural 'accord' with the pharmacy contract negotiators, Community Pharmacy England (formerly PSNC), and the British Medical Association.

The DDA has also been instrumental in the development of controlled localities in Scotland, and in the creation of dispensing GP-'friendly' control of entry regulations in Wales (2017).

In 2025, the DDA is running the Rural Access to Medicines and Pharmacy services Under Pressure (RAMP UP) campaign. A key focus of this campaign is to engage with the BMA GP Committee to achieve sustainable dispensary remuneration, which is negotiated separately to the main GP GMS contracts.



Membership
